
Clinic Corner

STUDENTS SCHOOL FEES NOTICE

Student Fee accounts have been updated and are available for review. Please log-in to your Infinite Campus Parent Portal account to view your students' posted fees.

For parents that would like to make payments electronically, fees can also be viewed on the *PayForIt.net* web site, once you have created an account and added your students to your account.

Credit card and electronic check payments may be processed through PayForIt. All buildings accept cash and check payments. Credit card payments can be processed on site at only Berea-Midpark High School and Middleburg Heights Jr. High School.

Fees are due within 30 days of October 1st. These include any past due amounts, instructional fees, first semester class fees, and miscellaneous fees for upcoming events (i.e. field trips).

Accounts with unpaid fees after the posted due date may be submitted to a collection company for further action.

Department Highlights: SCIENCE

The school year is off to a great start with many new and exciting additions! We are so happy to welcome Jill Weth to our department and building this year. Mrs. Weth will be teaching Physics and Chemistry here at BMHS and then head over to MHJH to finish up her day with 9th grade Physical Science. We are also offering 3 new courses this school year. What was once a semester course, Zoology is now broken up into an Invertebrate class and a Vertebrate class with each course covering one semester...so many animals, so little time! In addition to the Zoology course, our STEM program has expanded with the addition of STEM II. The STEM II class will focus on sustainable solutions for flooding problems and build a prototype of a levee that helps solve these flooding issues.
