HOMECOMING The Homecoming football game is Friday, October 5th at 7:00 at BW Finnie Stadium. The Homecoming Dance is on Saturday, October 6th, 6:00 to 10:00 P.M. in the BMHS Sports Center. Mandatory Breathalyzer testing will be administered to all students entering the dance. Tickets are \$15.00 each and will be sold during the lunch periods beginning Monday, September 17th through Friday, September 28th in the Activities Office. Guest dance forms, for a guest who does NOT attend BMHS, are available in the Activities Office and must be completed, with all required signatures, and turned in to the Activities Office before purchasing the guest's ticket. All BMHS student fees/fines must be paid prior to purchasing a dance ticket.

FROM THE CLINIC: IS YOUR CHILD PROTECTED?

New students and transfer students to Berea City Schools are required by law to provide proof of immunizations within **fifteen days** of entrance into the school system. Please do not rely on your previous school to forward this important and needed piece of information. If it is not forwarded in a timely fashion, your child may be required to miss school until it is provided. Those who for religious or medical reasons cannot be immunized must file an exemption each and every year with the school system.

Below you will find a chart of those immunizations required by the state of Ohio to be admitted and remain in school. If you have any questions please contact your School Health Specialist provided by Southwest General Healthcare Center at your local school for assistance. You can also check out the CDC recommendations, which are greater than the state requirements at http://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/recs/schedules/child-schedule.htm

5	DtaP, DTP, or DT (pediatric) *	5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT, or any combination, if the fourth dose was administered prior to the fourth birthday
3 or 4	Polio (IPV or OPV)	3 or 4 doses of IPV. The final dose must be administered on or after the fourth birthday regardless of the number of previous doses. Four doses if a combination of OPV and IPV was administered.
2	 Measles live virus Rubella Mumps live virus 	Usually given as MMR. Two doses of MMR. Dose one must be administered on or after the first birthday. The second dose must be administered at least twenty-eight days after the first dose.
3	Hepatitis B (HBV) Kindergarten- 12 th grade	3 doses of Hepatitis B. The second dose must be administered at least 28 days after the first dose. The third dose must be given at least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the second dose. The last dose in the series (third or fourth dose), must not be administered before age 24 weeks.
2	Varicella Kindergarten- 8 th grade	Usually given between 12-18 months of age, but can be administered at a later time. Kindergarten students are required to have 2 doses of varicella
1	Tdap	Required for 7-11grade
1 or 2	MCV4- Meningococcal	Grades7-9: One dose meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) Vaccine must be administered prior to entry. Grade 12: Two doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y). Vaccine must be administered prior to entry with one dose after age 16.



SIGN UP for REMIND text messages


