

FROM THE CLINIC: VISION/HEARING SCREENING INFORMATION

Dear Parents:

Vision and hearing screenings will be administered in September and October for all students in **ninth** grade and hearing screenings for **eleventh** grade at BMHS.

- If your child passes the vision and/or hearing screening, you will not be contacted by the school nurse.
- A vision or hearing screening provides only a snapshot of how your child performs on the
 day the test was administered and is not a substitute for a complete eye exam by an optometrist or ophthalmologist or hearing test by an audiologist.

If you child fails any screening, you will be informed of the test results. Please direct any questions to the school nurse at 216-267-2079.


